

If there is no road construction going I-75N above I-575 then use the following directions:

- 75 North to Exit 277 (Highway 92)
- Turn **Right** onto Highway 92.
- Go exactly 2 miles and turn **Left** onto Old Alabama Road. There is a sign right before it and at the bottom of the sign it points left and will say "Kellogg Day Use Area".



- Go exactly 1.2 miles till you get a stop sign and turn **Right** onto Kellogg Creek Road. It is where Old Alabama Road ends and there is a sign across the street that reads "Galts Ferry Day Use Areas" and points to the right.



- Go exactly 0.7 miles and turn **Left** onto Galts Ferry Road. The road sign is hard to see but Kellogg kind of veers to the right where you want to turn. You should see a sign pointing left that reads “Galts Ferry Day Use Area”.



- The entrance into Harbor Town is exactly **1.2** miles down Galts Ferry. On Galts Ferry it is going to look like you are going through an older neighborhood. Just keep going straight. You will go through 3 stop signs. At the 3rd stop the road splits and you want to veer **Right** and follow the sign to “Harbor Town Marina”.



- Go through the one way gate. You should see the parking lot that is in front of a building straight in front of you. Park anywhere in the paved parking lot.

If there is road construction going I-75N above I-575 then use the following Alternate Route.

- 75 North to Exit 268 (I-575).
- Continue on I-575 North to Exit 4 (Bells Ferry Road).
- Turn **Left** onto Bells Ferry Road.
- Go exactly **5.3** miles and turn **Left** at the light onto Kellogg Creek Road. There is an Exxon at the light on the left and it is the first light past the two Wal-Mart lights.
- Go exactly **3.2** miles and turn **Right** onto Galts Ferry Road. There is a sign there that indicates "Galts Ferry Day Use Area".



- The entrance into Harbor Town is exactly **1.2** miles down Galts Ferry. On Galts Ferry it is going to look like you are going through an older neighborhood. Just keep going straight. You will go through 3 stop signs. At the 3rd stop the road splits and you want to veer **Right** and follow the sign to "Harbor Town Marina".
- Go through the one way gate. You should see the parking lot that is in front of a building straight in front of you. Park anywhere in the paved parking lot.
